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HAMLETS

The monthly meeting of the Parish Council was held on Wednesday 15th July 2026. Attended by: Cllrs. J Hobbs (Chair), C Myers, N Steer, J Amos-Yeo, B Savage, R. Savage. J. Payne. Clerk J Steer, and one member of the public.

Cornwall Cllr Faye Emery was unable to attend due to a last-minute emergency, but forwarded a report containing an explanation of the steps which would be required by the Parish Council in order to produce a Neighbourhood Priorities Statement. An update on potential EV charging - it may be in the best interest of the PC to look at funding alternatives in order to provide the facility themselves, and finally, on Cleave Crescent, SLOW markings have been painted on the road. Residents are currently awaiting installation of signs.

The usual Parish maintenance matters were covered. Treefella Southwest has completed the removal of a number of trees around the playing fields, with parishioners benefitting from the logs from the felled trees. Please see the Draft minutes on the website or The Parish Council noticeboard for full details of Parish maintenance. The issues with overgrown splays at Crimp Junction & Stursdon Cross had recently been reported to Oliver Jones, who responded very quickly (within 48 hrs). Two Policies received their annual review (The Welcome Pack & The Safeguarding Policy). All MPC policies can be found on the Parish Councils Website, as can the full draft minutes for all Council meetings.

The Parish Council were concerned to hear about the recent activity at Crimp Junction and Stursdon Cross - The Parish Council would like to remind ALL Parishioners that residents should NOT take matters into their own hands as this presents clear risks, not only potential safety concerns for the individuals, but also in terms of the implications for damage caused to vehicles by debris – for which those undertaking such tasks would be financially responsible.

With regard to this and any other Parish Maintenance matter - Comments on social Media, or via word of mouth are unlikely to reach the clerk. Any concerns **SHOULD ALWAYS** be reported directly to the clerk, who has a direct line to those responsible for dealing with such matters and can often expediate any necessary action required.
